HEALTH HAZARD DATA

First Aid Procedures

INHALATION - Remove victim to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Contact physician.

SKIN & EYE CONTACT - Wash with large amounts of water for 15 minutes.

INGESTION - Contact physician. Drink water to dilute. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to do so by a physician.

Carcinogenicity - Not listed or regulated as a carcinogen.

Medical Conditions Aggravated By Exposure - None known.

PERSONAL PROTECTION RECOMMENDATIONS

Protective gloves, goggles and NIOSH/OSHA approved respirator in confined areas.

Wash hands thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE
